#### **Date & venue**

Saturday August 22 2026 at the Eulogy Lounge, Whanganui Race Course 19 Purnell Street, Whanganui, New Zealand

#### **Doors open to the public (through public entrance)**

09.30am

#### **Start times**

- Kata 10.00 am

There will be a 30 minute break at the completion of the Kata section, followed by the Kumite Section

- Kumite estimated start time between 11.30am – 12.00pm. All Kumite competitors must be present at 11am to ensure they are aware of their confirmed bout start times.

#### **Spectator fees – CASH ONLY:**

Adults & High School students \$10

Primary school children \$5

#### **Entry form & fees**

\$50.00 Kumite/\$30 Kata non-refundable

Entry form and entry fee must be received on or before Friday August 7 2026

#### **Payment of fees**

#### **Kata**

Competitors will select a kata to perform from the grade level on the entry form. Divisions are in elimination tournament format. Kata will be performed individually.

#### **Junior Kumite (8-14 years)**

Bouts are 1.5 minute duration with the possibility of 2 times 1 minute extensions.

#### **Colts Kumite (15-17 years)**

Bouts are 2 minute duration with the possibility of 2 times 1 minute extensions.

#### **Adults (18 years and over)**

Bouts are 3 minute duration with the possibility of 2 times 2 minute extensions.

**The organiser (MOKNZ) retains the right to split, amalgamate or cancel any division depending on the numbers of entries. Divisions may be changed to match fights or round robin. Initial rounds will be matched as closely as possible. Ruling for all Kumite divisions will be under MOKNZ knock down rules.**

**Weigh in & registration all competitors: (through competitor's entrance)**

8.45am at the tournament venue.

**No leniency will be given for differences to the above weight divisions. If a competitor's weight is not within the category selected on their entry form they will not compete in that division or may be disqualified.**

**Compulsory Protective Gear**

**JUNIORS (8 – 14 years)**

- Gloves, shin pads, and mouth guards, COMPETITORS TO PROVIDE
- Head Gear (provided)
- Body armour to be worn by juniors 10 years old and under.

***Shin pads and gloves must be soft, pull on, foam only.***

*Body armour must be as pictured below. These will be inspected by the organising team.*

**COLTS (15 – 17 years)**

Head gear provided, shin pads and mouth guard, COMPETITORS TO PROVIDE. **No** Gloves for Colts Division.

**Junior and Colts competitors will not be permitted to participate if this gear is not worn**

**Groin Guards for male competitors is now compulsory.**

**Optional Protective Gear**

- Women – breast protection – **soft**, cup style, inserted into sports bra.

***Plastic protectors covering the sternum not Permitted. Women's protective gear must be made available for inspection to tournament organisers. Examples Below***



- ***Mouth guards are compulsory for all competitors..***
- ***ALL PROTECTIVE GEAR MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE WEIGH IN FOR INSPECTION.***
